

Gloucester County 4-H Event Participation Guidelines

We look forward to your child(ren) being involved in the Gloucester County 4-H Youth Development Program through club participation as well as in various events and activities. This document provides some important guidelines for your reference. Please make note of the information below.

4-H MEMBER REGISTRATIONS/RE-ENROLLMENTS

Completed Gloucester County 4-H member registrations/re-enrollments must be received in the county 4-H office by January 1 of each year to qualify 4-Her's for participation in all county, state and national competitive events, including the annual 4-H Fair.

It is the responsibility of **PARENTS**, rather than 4-H club leaders to mail/fax or deliver the registration and/or re-enrollment form to the 4-H office.

MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING REQUIREMENTS

In general, all 4-H members are expected to meet the following standards each year. These are the minimum requirements. Your club may have additional requirements.

- Attend at least 70 percent of regular club meetings and/or activities.
- Complete a 4-H project, doing one's own work with minimal assistance from parents or others.
- Give a club and/or county 4-H public presentation. (Club judging sheets must be stapled to the record book when turned in to the office in order to participate at the 4-H Fair).
- Complete a project record book.

In addition to individual and national event rules and regulations, youth must be enrolled as a registered 4-H member by January 1 of each year to enter any Gloucester County, New Jersey state or national 4-H competitive event – including the selection process for National 4-H Conference, National 4-H Congress and Citizenship Washington Focus.

This policy is effective for all county, state and national competitive events, including the annual 4-H Fair.
