(on the front page) and This project has encouraged me to... (on the last page).</i></p>		
LIFE SKILLS	<p>2 points=minimal explanation; not a complete sentence</p> <p>5 points=sentences but not expanded thoughts</p> <p>8 points=exceptional and thorough</p>		
PROJECT ACTIVITIES	<p>Must have at least one learning experience for project to be considered complete. Even if a 4-Her registered for a project and then did not follow through there was a learning experience.</p> <p>For example, "I planned to learn how to sew but learned that I need to make sure I have time to take sewing classes in order to learn more about how to sew."</p> <p>2 points=minimal learning experiences, learning not explained or explained at a basic level</p> <p>5 points=some learning experiences, learning explained at a basic level</p> <p>8 points=exceptional number of learning experiences, learning explained thoroughly and in depth</p>		
PROJECT COMMUNICATIONS	<p>Must have at least one project communication for a project to be considered complete.</p> <p>2 points=If at least one project communication is not recorded, then the 4-Her needs to write an explanation as to why he/she did not do a project communication in regards to this project.</p> <p>5 points=Had 1-2 communications in project area</p> <p>8 points=3 or more communications in project area</p>		
PROJECT EXHIBITS	<p>Must have at least one project exhibit for a project to be considered complete. If at least one project exhibit is not recorded, then the 4-Her needs to write an explanation as to why he/she did not exhibit in regards to this project.</p>		
INCOME AND EXPENSES	<p>2 points=expenses and income recorded with errors and/or exclusions</p> <p>5 points=expenses and income recorded with minimal exclusions</p> <p>8 points=exceptional and detailed records; all income and expenses recorded with details</p>
